

Wireless networking at the Millburn Public Library



The library is a Wi-Fi hotspot

Library patrons who own laptops or PDAs equipped for wireless connectivity can now access the Internet in the following areas:

- Main (Adult) section of the library
- on the mezzanine.
- in the Children's Room
- in Conference Room A

Through the wireless network patrons will not only have access to the Internet, but to the Library's many reference databases as well.

Please note:

- Wireless patrons will not be able to print.
- All Internet sites are available as is the Item, however BCCLS databases that cannot be accessed from home with a library card number cannot be accessed from a WiFi connected laptop.
- Wireless patrons must conform to the Library's Internet Use Policy.
- Signal strength may vary in the building.
- Access to electrical outlets is limited.
 - Please make sure that your device's battery is fully charged.
- Library staff cannot provide technical assistance to wireless users.
